Robert A. Cooper of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, October 2, 2002 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 69.

Born December 1, 1932 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Robert H. and Clara Bien Cooper. As a young child he and his family moved to Tilghman, MD where he attended public school. Following his graduation from St. Michaels High School in 1949, he worked in the family grocery store and following its sale, worked at Tilghman Packing Company. He then worked for Edward H. Higgins & Son Seafood and has remained in the seafood business until his time of death.

He was a member of Granite Lodge A.F.&A.M., Easton Elks Lodge # 1622, Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum, Talbot Historical Society and a life member of the Tilghman Vol. Fire Dept.

Mr. Cooper is survived by his wife, the former Grace Haddaway, whom he married January 14, 1951; a daughter, Brenda C. Davidson and her husband, Jim of Easton; a sister, Barbara C. Higgins of Winter Haven, FL; a dear aunt, Faye Sinclair of Easton; two grandchildren, Bobby Davidson of Baltimore and Laura Davidson of Towson to whom he was affectionately known as "Pops"; and several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, October 6, 2002 at 4:00 PM at Tilghman United Methodist Church, Tilghman, MD where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Private interment will be at Tilghman Memorial Cemetery.
