



## Roberta Jean Hall Stephens

July 23, 1920 - August 22, 2013

Roberta Hall Stephens, MD, died on August 22, 2013, at Genesis Healthcare at the Pines in Easton. She was 93.

She was born on July 23, 1920, in Freemansburg, WV, to the late Harvey A. Hall and Mable McGinnis Hall. Dr. Stephens attended High School in Weston, WV, graduating Class of 1938. She continued her education, receiving a Bachelor's Degree from West Virginia University and a medical degree from the Medical College of Virginia in 1945.

After college, she began interning at St. Louis City Hospital until coming back to Weston, WV, to practice medicine with two surgeons at Weston City Hospital. In 1958, she graduated from the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health with a Masters Degree in Public Health. In 1966, she began working with Queen Anne's and Caroline Counties as the County Health Officer, until retiring in 1981.

On August 7, 1948, she married Charles H. Stephens. Due to her husband's military career, they moved all over the world. In 1966, she and her husband moved to Queen Anne's County, MD, residing in Centreville. After her retirement in 1981, they resided in Pinehurst, NC, from 1983 to 2002, when they moved to the Londonderry Retirement Community in Easton, MD.

A service of Christian burial will be held on Saturday, September 7, 2013, at 11 a.m. at Old Wye Episcopal Church, 14114 Old Wye Mills Rd, Wye Mills, MD. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.
