



Roberta "Bobbie" Harrison

September 26, 1937 - July 30, 2012

Roberta L. Harrison, affectionately known as "Miss Bobbie," passed away on Monday, July 30, 2012. surrounded by her loving family. She was 74.

Born September 26, 1937, in Baltimore, she was the daughter of the late Robert Preston and Katharine Marie Trainer Lambdin. Following graduation from St. Michaels High School, she attended Strayer Business College. On October 27, 1957, she married Levin F. Harrison, III (Captain Buddy).

Miss Bobbie worked at Maryland National Bank on Tilghman Island for a number of years and then joined the family business full time during the "boom" oyster years in the early 1970's. She was Chief Financial Officer of Harrison Oyster Company in the 1970's and 1980's. She became the CFO of Harrison's Chesapeake House in 1979 and held the position until 2011. In the year 2000, Miss Bobbie was named Business Woman of the Year by the Talbot County Chamber of Commerce. She enjoyed preparing and donating food to the local church and fire company. Miss Bobbie has won various awards over the years for her cooking specialties and was known locally for baking delicious cakes.

In addition to her husband, Miss Bobbie is also survived by two sons, Levin F. Harrison, IV (Bud), and his wife Leslie; Charles R. Harrison (Chuck) and his wife Judy; seven grandchildren, Beau, Chase, Brooks, Bryce, Hunter,

Camden, and Bryleigh; and a sister, Leatrice Cornelia Lambdin. She was predeceased by a sister, Charlotte Louise Tucker, and a brother, Joseph Preston Lambdin, who died as an infant.

Services will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2012, at Tilghman United Methodist Church at 2 p.m. Friends may call on Monday, August 6, 2012, at St. John's Chapel from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Burial will be at St. John's Cemetery, Tilghman, MD.
