



Roberta "Bobbie" Marshall

September 6, 1928 - August 16, 2011

Mrs. Roberta H. "Bobbie" Marshall, of St. Michaels, passed away Tuesday, Aug. 16, 2011 after a lengthy illness at the home of her daughter. She was 82. Born Sept. 6, 1928 on Tilghman's Island, she was the daughter of Herman H. Harrison and Ada Ridgeway. She graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1945 as Valedictorian of her class. She attended Goldey College in Wilmington, DE, where she studied accounting. In 1947, she married Marion "Junie" Marshall. He preceded her in death in 2005.

Mrs. Marshall worked for the St. Michaels Utilities Commission and as Assistant Clerk and Bookkeeper for the Town of St. Michaels. She was a member of the Miles River Yacht Club, the Chesapeake Bay Log Sailing Canoe Association for which she served as Secretary/Treasurer for many years, the Upper Shore Genealogical Society, and the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum.

"Miss Bobbie" loved her Eastern Shore heritage and took pleasure in researching and sharing her knowledge of the area. She enjoyed photography and writing for local magazines.

She is survived by three children, Robert Marshall (Alice) of McDaniel, Bonnie Messick (Gene) of St. Michaels and Kate Benton of Hotchkiss, CO; two brothers, Herman Harrison (Kitty) of McDaniel and Heath Harrison (Joan) of Jupiter, FL; and eight grandchildren, Carrie Hill Kennedy of Stafford, VA, Don Hill of Ft.
