Robert B. Santangelo of Rock Hall, MD died on July 11, 2010 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 72.

He was born on September 18, 1937 in Brooklyn, New York, the son of the late, John and Viola (Cardone) Santangelo. He graduated Fort Hamilton High School and attended St. Johns University. Mr. Santangelo enlisted and served in the U.S. Army Reserves. He married Dorothy Boardman on September 28, 1958. They resided in Brooklyn, NY where he owned and operated his families' business, RoxArt Manufacturing Co., until he sold the business. When living in Long Island he served as an usher for the Cure of Ars Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus. He was also past member and treasurer of the Merrick Yacht Club. Mr. Santangelo then opened Moonlight Bay Inn and Marina in Rock Hall, MD. He attended St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall and was a member of Greater Rock Hall Business Association and the Kent County Lodging Association. He enjoyed boating and gardening.

In addition to his wife, Dorothy, he is survived by three sons, Mark Santangelo and his wife, Amy of Woodstock, MD, Rob Santangelo of Rock Hall, MD and Jeffrey Santangelo of Baltimore, MD; a daughter-in-law, Marie Santangelo of Centreville, MD; a sister, Nina Kilarjian and her husband, Robert of Northport, NY; and a sister-in-law, Aurelia Santangelo. He is also survived by grandchildren, Gabrielle, Zachary, Nicholas and Amber.
