Robert Caywood Robson of Bozman, MD died on Tuesday, April 19, 2005 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 83.

Born in Marlboro, New York June 19, 1921, he was the son of the late Constantine and Marion Caywood Robson. He was raised in New York City where he graduated from Stuyvesant High School. He attended Cornell University and while at Cornell became interested in aviation. He left Cornell to teach flying in South Carolina during World War II. After the war, he joined American Airlines as a pilot and soon became known as "Ace Robson". He retired in 1981 after 38 years of service. While based in Washington, D.C. with American Airlines, he wrote for Aviation Week and had a radio program on aviation.

In 1980 he moved to Bozman where he could enjoy his hobbies of gardening, painting and cooking. He was an avid collector of tools and enjoyed using them in his workshop.

Mr. Robson is survived by his wife of 22 years, the former Harriett Jacobs; one son, Montgomery Robson and his wife Suellen of New Milford, CT; two daughters, Connie Robson and Sherri Robson of Bantan, CT; a sister, Marion Gow and her husband Arthur of Hondo, TX; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren. He was predeceased by his former wife Bess M. Robson who

died in 1999.
