August 22, 1920 - June 23, 2009

Robert Donald McCleary, Sr. of Chestertown, MD died on Tuesday June 23, 2009 at Washington Hospital Center. He was 88.

Born on August 22, 1920 in Towson, MD he was the son of the late, Harry Raymond and Cora Elva Hanna McCleary. Mr. McCleary graduated from Towson High School Class of 1938. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII stateside and was honorably discharged in 1945. He worked as a Foreman for Conrail Railroad in Baltimore, MD for 43 years, retiring in 1981.

He was a member of the Mt. Nebo Masonic Lodge, Scottish Right and the Boumi Temple, as a Shriner Mr. McCleary transported children to the Pennsylvania Shriners Hospital. As a string band member for 15 years he participated in many Shriners parades. He loved to work with the Shriners and was active in Church. He also loved to play music, he played the electric guitar and had his own band.

Mr. McCleary is survived by his wife of 40 years, Hilda J. McCleary; two sons, Robert D. McCleary, Jr. of Cockeysville, MD and Albert R. McCleary of Pheonix, MD; five grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren. A brother, Richard Pierce McCleary recently predeceased him.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2009 at 11:00 AM at

Wesley Hall at Heron Point. Interment will be in the Memorial Garden.
