Robert Earl Benson of Stevensville, MD died on Tuesday, May 6, 2003 at Spa Creek Genesis Eldercare, Annapolis, MD. He was 85.

Born August 10, 1917 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Robert Lee and Theresa Dayton Benson. He graduated from Catonsville High School and following graduation he began working. On August 14, 1942 he married the former Mary Elizabeth Grisbach of Baltimore and for many years they made their home in Woodlawn, MD. In 1943 he was drafted into the U.S. Navy and served with the Sea Bees in the South Pacific during World War II. Following his release from active duty he returned home and began working with Wolk Printing as a paper cutter. In 1995 he and his wife moved to the Eastern Shore where they resided in Stevensville.

He was a life long New York Yankees fan.

Mr. Benson is survived by his loving and devoted wife, Mary Elizabeth Grisbach Benson; a loving daughter, Mary Carter and her husband, James Robert Carter of Romancoke, MD; devoted son, Robert L. Benson and his wife, Bridget of Ellicott City, MD; a dear sister, Florence Zapresko of St. Petersburg, FL and a loving granddaughter, Tracy Anne Carter of Fairfield, PA. He was pre-deceased by a brother, Kenneth Benson and a sister, Elsie Vitzs.

Funeral services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Chester, MD on Friday, May 9, 2003 at 10:00 AM where friends and family may call one hour prior to the service.
