Robert E. Hauk of Easton died at the University of Maryland Medical Center, Baltimore, MD on Thursday, August 10, 2006. He was 78.

Born in Baltimore, MD on March 11, 1928, he was the son of the late, John Edward and Agnes Mechlinski Hauk. He graduated from Baltimore Polytechnic Institute in 1946. He attended the University of Baltimore graduating in 1959. In 1949 he began his lifelong civil service career working with the U.S. Treasury Dept. in Baltimore. In the late 1950's he worked in Washington, DC in the Excise Tax Section. In 1973 he became a supervisor and at the time of his retirement he held the title of Chief at the National Office. He served in the Army National Guard for 10 years in Maryland and Florida where he was recognized as a rifle and marksman in military tournaments.

He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church. His leisure time he spent camping in tents and RVs from Maine to Florida with his family. He enjoyed building and flying model aircraft which he began in the 1940's, fishing and writing his own novel "The Raft" under the pen name, Edward Russell.

His wife, Mary Frances Schmitt, whom he married in 1962, died on December 6, 1999.

Mr. Hauk is survived by two sons, David E. Hauk and his wife, Jin Han of Catonsville and Stephen R. Hauk and his wife, Jessica Kendall Hauk of North Providence, RI; a sister, Dorothy Milan of Rio Rico, AZ; one niece and six nephews. In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by a sister, Marie Buck.
