



## Robert E.L. Taylor

Robert E.L. Taylor of Queenstown, MD died on Monday, April 21, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 73.

Born June 9, 1929 in Prince George's County, he was the son of Willie E. and Laura Wootten Wheat of Queenstown. After attending Baltimore City public schools, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corp in 1946 where he served with the 1st Helicopter Squadron, Marine Air Corp Wing in Cherry Point, NC. Following his release from active duty with the rank of Corporal in 1949, he attended Baltimore City College. Later that same year he reenlisted in the Marine Corp where he was an aircraft mechanic until 1953. Following his release from active duty with the rank of Sergeant, he worked at various jobs until 1954, when he took a position as conductor for the B & O Railroad where he remained until retiring in 1964 for health reasons.

A life member of Lafayette Masonic Lodge #111 of Cockeysville, MD, he was also a member of the Past Masters Association, the Scottish Rite of Free Masonry S.J. of Baltimore, MD and American Legion Post #0278, Stevensville, MD.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Taylor is survived by a daughter, Roberta Ellis of Philadelphia, PA; two sons, Patrick Taylor of Philadelphia, PA and Scott Taylor of Baltimore, MD; and two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, April 25, 2003 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD.

Friends may call at the funeral home on Thursday evening from 6 to 8 PM where a Masonic service will be held at 7:30 PM.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
