



Robert G. Gise

June 12, 1921 - May 25, 2008

Robert Girvan Gise of Centreville, MD died Sunday May 25, 2008 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 86.

Born on June 12, 1921 in Baltimore, MD. He was the son of the late Howard O. Gise and Dorothy Potter Gise. Bob grew up primarily in Baltimore, but spent his summers on his grandfather's farm on Wye Island in Queenstown, MD. There he began a love for farming and the outdoors. After moving to Queen Anne's County in 1936 he attended Centreville High School and began managing and farming his father's farm, Brookside Farm, in Queenstown, MD. Bob married Lois Southard at St. Luke's Chapel in Queenstown, MD. on Dec. 17, 1948. While farming, he also drove a school bus in Queen Anne's county for 15 years. When the family farm was sold, he worked as a folding foreman for 5 years at Tidewater Publishing Corporation in Centreville, MD. Following that, he worked outdoors again at Wye Institute and Aspen Institute for 10 years, where he retired in the early 1990's. Bob loved wood working and reading and in his earlier years was a Scout Master for the Queenstown Boy Scout Troop, served as a member on both the Queen Anne's County Park Board and Fair Board. He was a member of the St. Luke's Chapel in Queenstown, MD. and Old Wye Church in Wye Mills, MD.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 59 years, Lois S. Gise and their three children; son, Glenn A. Gise and wife Mary of Phoenix, MD. And two

daughters, Sally G. Rosenberry of Centreville, MD and Adele Quatmann and husband David of West Chester, PA. and five (5) grandchildren. A sister, Gloria G. Swindell, predeceased him on May 12, 2008.

A graveside committal service will be held 11 AM on Friday, May 30, 2008 at Old Wye Church Cemetery in Wye Mills, MD.
