Robert Joseph Kelly died at his home in Easton on Saturday June 5, 2004. He was 76.

Born in Baltimore on November 25, 1927, he was the son of the late Robert Rainey and Elizabeth Smith Kelley. He was a graduate of Baltimore Polytechnic Institute, University of Maryland School of Pharmacy and the University of Baltimore School of Law. During World War II, he served in the United States Navy as crew leader of a Crash and Rescue unit in Norfolk, VA. A pharmacist for 50 years, Mr. Kelly was employed by Parke Davis Company, Hill's Drug Store, Drug Fair and was Chief Pharmacist at the Eastern Shore Hospital Center in Cambridge, MD. He had also worked for the MD Board of Fire Underwriters, the Talbot County State's Attorney's Office as a Narcotics Criminal Investigator and the Talbot County District Court as Commissioner.

A member of St. Andrews The Seafarer Chapel in Easton, he was also a member of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, E.E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V. F. W., and the Sherlock Holmes Society. He was a volunteer for the College Park Fire Department, the Talbot County Red Cross, the Veterans Administration Medical Clinic and The Talbot County Committee for Individuals with Disabilities.

Mr. Kelly is survived by his wife of 35 years, the former Monica Dise; five

children, Kevin Capozzoli, Patricia Smith, Marci Lambert, Robert Rainey Kelly, and Colin Matthew Kelly; nine grandchildren, Jessica and Jimmy Pokrandt, Shannon and Allyson Pinder, Robbie, Christian and Meghan Smith and Margaret and Audrey Lambert; and two great-grandchildren, Isaiah and Elijah Warren. A sister, Elizabeth Anne Kelly is deceased.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, June 10, 2004 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
