Robert J. Wright, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Friday, November 15, 2002. He was 83.

Born in Hawthorne, NJ, September 5, 1919, he was the son of the late Robert J. and Sarah Hunt Wright. After graduating from the Hawthorne High School in 1936, he attended Lehigh University where he earned his Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1940. While in college, he was on the Dean's List. earned four varsity letters in various sports and was a member of the Asa Packer Society . During his professional career, he had been associated with the Wright Aeronautical Corp., the FMC Corp and the Garrett Corporation from which he retired in 1984 with the position of Group Vice President of Sales and Service.

Other professional and business activities included the Board of Directors of the Garrett Corp., Vice President and Board member of Garrett International in Geneva, Board member of Normalair Ltd in Yeovil, England, member of the U. S. Trade Industry Advisory Committee, Alternate Director of the General Aviation Manufacturers Association Board and attendee at the Aerospace Industries Association Board Meetings for five years.

After retirement, he moved to the Easton area where he was a member of the Miles River Sail and Power Squadron, the Poplar Island Yacht Club and the

Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

Mr. Wright is survived by his wife, the former Suzanne Brodeur whom he married in 1946; three children, Robert James Wright II of Miami Beach, FL, Pamela S. Hughes of Washington, D.C. and Jeffrey M. Wright of Gaithersburg, MD and five grandchildren, Heather Wright, Christopher Wright, Matthew Bodnar, Victoria Bodnar and Amanda Wright. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Doris Wright Terhune.

Memorial services will be held at Trinity Cathedral, Easton, on Monday, November 18th, at 10 A. M.

Burial will be private.
