August 10, 1934 - June 2, 2010

Robert Joseph Hummel of Stevensville, MD died on Wednesday, June 2, 2010 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 75 years old.

Born on August 10, 1934 in East Orange, New Jersey, he was the son of the late, Robert Tillman Hummel and Gertrude Ida Weigman. Bob grew up in Toms River, NJ and was honorably discharged from the US Navy in 1954. He married Eileen Davidson in 1957 and relocated to Pennsylvania after the birth of their first child.

Bob had a life long passion for boating and the water and moved to Kent Island in 1985

where he started Midlantic Marine. He sold the business in 2000 and retired. He was a boat captain and pilot as well as a member of the Kent Island Elks, the American Legion and the Kent Island Cruisers.
