A Funeral Liturgy for Robert Joseph Leonhardt, of Annapolis, MD will be celebrated at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Kings Park, N.Y. on Friday, November 17, 2006 at 10 :30 A.M.

Mr. Leonhardt died at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD on Sunday, November 12, 2006. He was 84.

Born in New York, December 23, 1921, he was the son of the late Harry and Ethel Gorey Leonhardt. After graduating from the Stuyvesant High School in 1939, he attended the City College of New York and Adelphi College on Long Island. During World War II, he served in the U. S. Navy and was later recalled for active duty for the Korean Conflict and ran the naval shipyard in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. An aeronautical engineer, he worked for forty years in the aerospace industry. He was first associated with Sperry Gyroscope, then Kollsman Instruments and, finally Grumman Aerospace from which he retired in 1984. He had been involved in every major aerospace project and, at the time of his retirement, was working on the F-14 project.

Following his retirement, he moved from Long Island to Heritage Harbour in Annapolis He was an avid sailor and golfer.

His wife, the former Adeline L. Grautraud whom he married January 27, 1945

in Laurelton, Long Island, NY, died February 10, 2005.

Mr. Leonhardt is survived by a daughter, Lynn L. Mielke, of Easton, MD.

Burial will be at the Calverton National Cemetery, Calverton, N.Y.
