A Funeral Liturgy for Robert Lee "Duke" Wood of Queen Anne, MD will be celebrated at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Cordova, MD on Monday, December 27, 2004 at 10:00 AM. Mr. Wood died on Monday, December 20, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 69.

Born January 6, 1935 in Centreville, he was the son of the late John Lawrence, Sr. and Mary Knott Wood. After graduating from Centreville High School in 1955, he served in the U.S. Marine Corps. Following his release from active duty in 1959, he worked for the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture on an experimental farm in the Freehold, NJ area. In 1966 he moved to Queen Anne where he farmed the Meadowbrook Farm until its sale in 1998.

Mr. Wood attended the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church of Marydel and was a lifetime member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Cordova. A member of the Camden, DE Moose Lodge and the Modern Maturity Center of Dover, DE, he was also a former member of The Regina Coeli Council #2274 Knights of Columbus. He enjoyed dancing, traveling and spending time with his family.

Mr. Wood is survived by his former wife, Sally Thompson; six children and their spouses, Scott and Donna Wood, Jack and Charlene Wood, Phil and Barbara Wood, Lisa and Gary Pippin, Lynn and Vince Payne and Dawn and

George Brode; fourteen grandchildren, Emily, Mary Ellen and Clayton Wood, Joey, Alex and Christopher Wood, Jake and Matt Wood, Ben, Ryan, Chris and Russell Payne, and Chris and Matt Brode. He is also survived by two sisters and one brother, Delores Fountain, Alice and Joe Uher and David and Rosemary Wood; two sisters-in-law, Eleanor and Joyce Wood; a friend, Robert Boring, whom he helped raise; and a very special friend and companion, Ann Smith. In addition to his parents, Mr. Wood is preceded in death by two brothers, Donald Wood who died in 1992 and John Lawrence Wood, Jr. who died in 2001.
