Robert Louis Yoos of Chestertown, MD died on Wednesday, March 23, 2011 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 78 years old.

Robert was born on April 11, 1932 in Baltimore City, MD. He was the son of the late, Albert and Lillian Hartlove Yoos. He graduated from Patterson Park High School and enlisted in 1952 in the United States Air Force. He served as a Morse code operator in Alaska during the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1956. He returned to Baltimore and married Frances Kramer on January 24, 1959.
