Robert Otto Linder, Sr. of Centreville died on Monday, May 7, 2001 at the Kent Queen Anne's Hospital, Chestertown. He was 75.

Born in Long Beach, NY on May 23, 1925, he was the son of the late Robert and Viola Geibel Linder. Following his graduation from high school in 1942 he entered the U.S. Navy where he served during World War II in the South Pacific. He was honorably discharged in 1946. Following his release from active duty he returned to New York and worked in the family business in marine construction known as R.O. Linder, Inc. Pile Drivers. In 1947 he married the former Marijoan Antonius and in 1963 they moved to Rock Hall, MD where he also moved his marine construction business. In 1972 he transferred the business to Rolcom, a foundation pile driving company where he continued until retiring in 1995. Mrs. Linder died in 1991.

He enjoyed fishing, hunting, decoy carving and was an avid trap and skeet shooter. He dabbled in computer technology. He was a member of the Nassau Trap and Skeet Association and the Rock Hall Yacht Club.

Mr. Linder is survived by two sons, Robert O. Linder, Jr. of Centreville, MD and Lawrence O. Linder of Easton, MD; two daughters, JoAnn Edwards of Rock Hall, MD and Carol Knapp of Blowing Rock, NC; nine grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

A Memorial Service will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Centreville on Friday, May 11, 2001 at 8:00 PM where friends may call from 6:00 – 8:00.
