Robert Philip Maul of Quincy, Pa. died Tuesday, Oct.10, 2000, in the Quincy United Methodist Home. He was 74.

Born on Nov. 7, 1925 in Kingston, Pa., he was the son of the late William R. and Grace Cameron-Maul. He lived his early life in York, Pa. He graduated from Gramby High School in Norfolk, Va. in 1943 and then attended V.M.I. (Virginia Military Institute) for one year. He served with the United States 3rd Army of the 97th Infantry Division during World War II, serving in the European Theater and eight months with the Army of Occupation in Japan. He was married to Mrs. M. Carolyn Dedmon-Maul on Sept. 18, 1948 in Washington, D.C. They had lived many years on the Eastern Shore until they moved to Quincy Village.

Following discharge from the military he returned to college and received his Bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Maryland in 1950. He was employed with Mclean Contracting Company in Baltimore for 40 years. His last position was executive vice-president. He retired in 1987. He was a life member of the Grasonville V.F.W. Post 7464. He was also a member of the Kent Island Yacht Club, V.M.I. Alumni Asso., Phi Sigma Kappa Fraternity and the Beta Alpha Psi, National Accounting Fraternity.

In addition to his wife of 52 years, Mr. Maul is survived by a daughter, Linda A.
