Robby attended Norwood School in Potomac, MD, before moving to the Eastern Shore of Maryland where he attended The Country School, Easton, MD. His high school years were spent at the Episcopal High School, Alexandria, VA. He continued his education at Stetson University, Deland, FL graduating in 2007 with a B. S. Degree in Business Administration. He was currently employed with Fidelity Investments as a Financial Advisor.

Robby will be remembered for his uncanny sense of humor and zest for life. “He was a brilliant, generous and caring young man, and a constant ray to sunshine in my life,” remarks a close college friend. “He touched a lot of people on this campus and had tons of friends.
