



## Robert S. Carter

Robert S. Carter of Easton, died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Friday October 28, 2005. He was 79.

Born on November 15, 1925 in Poughkeepsie, New York he was the son of the late Edward S. and Isobel Sague Carter. After attending Poughkeepsie Day School and the Deerfield Academy, he then attended Princeton and Harvard Universities. His college education was interrupted when he enlisted in the U.S. Navy, where he served as a radar technician during WWII achieving the rank of Petty Officer. Following his release from active duty he returned to Harvard University where in 1951 he graduated with a PhD in Nuclear Physics. Mr. Carter worked as a research scientist with Westinghouse and the National Bureau of Standards. He supervised the design, building and operation of the Bureau's research reactor, developing it into one of the major national research centers of its kind. Before retiring as Chief of the Radiation Division in 1989, he acquired a cold neutron source that greatly expanded the reactor's capabilities.

In his retirement Mr. Carter enjoyed sailing, tennis, building model ships and trains doing projects around his yard and home, and spending time at the ocean with his family. He and his beloved wife "Toni" traveled all over the world, including visits to India, Jordan, Russia and the Amazon jungle.

In addition to his wife the former Marie "Toni" Russo, whom he married on August 21, 1949 Mr. Carter is survived by four children; Robert S. Carter, Jr, Susan Carter Oldrieve, Edward Carter and Lissa Carter and nine grandchildren; Jonathan Burchmore, Katherine Burchmore, Elizabeth Burchmore, Edward Carter, Daniel Carter, Ashley Carter, Megan Carter, Braden Drooz and Cameron Drooz.

A memorial Service will be held at 3:00PM on Saturday, November 5, 2005 at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A. Easton, where friends are invited one hour prior to service.

Burial will be private.
