



## Robert Stanton Fox

Robert Stanton Fox of Easton, MD, formerly of Royal Oak, died on Tuesday, November 12, 2002 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 89.

Born September 27, 1913 in Sandusky, Ohio, he was the son of the late Edward and Elsa Schwer Fox. A graduate of the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, where he earned a degree in naval architecture and marine engineering, he served on the design staff of Bethlehem Steel Company-Fore River Yard in Quincy, MA. In 1947 he opened his own office for naval architecture and yacht brokerage in Duxbury, MA.

A resident of Maryland's Eastern Shore since 1977, he was, for many years, an active member of the St. Michaels Maritime Museum and an early member of the Chesapeake Chapter of the Antique Classic Boat Society. He was an avid and well-known collector of all things marine.

Mr. Fox is survived by his wife, Patricia McMahon Fox, whom he married in 1977; three daughters, Marie E. Young of Petaluma, CA, Josie Hanlon of Cambridge, MA and Robin Daly of Duxbury, MA; five grandchildren, David, Robin, Alexandra, Rebecca and Robert; and the mother of his children, Marie Haffenreffer Fox of Duxbury, MA. A son, Peter Marlin Fox is deceased.

A Memorial Service will be held on Friday, November 22, 2002 at 11:00 AM at

Christ Episcopal Church, Easton.

Inurnment at the Oxford Columbarium, Oxford Cemetery will be private.
