



## Robert T. Andrews

Robert T. Andrews of Choptank died Thursday, May 12, 2005 at the home of his daughter in Lewes, DE after a heroic battle against pancreatic cancer. He was 62.

Born on June 20, 1942 in Easton, he was the son of Isabell Belle Andrews of Ridgely and the late Thomas J. Andrews of Easton. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1960 and fought in the Vietnam War as a member of the 1st Infantry. He was awarded The Purple Heart, Bronze Star Medal and Medal of Honor. Following his honorable discharge in 1968 he began a career as a brick layer until he had to retire for health reasons. He also received the Congressional Medal of Honor.

Mr. Andrews was a member of the E. E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W; Moose Lodge 1520, both of Easton, and the Hurlock American Legion Post 243.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by his wife, the former Nancy Eason Harrison whom he married on August 31, 1962; three daughters, Candy Stevens of Cambridge, Barbara Barbie Andrews of Lewes, DE and Shannon Andrews Philiposian of Hurlock; a sister, Phyllis McDaniel of Easton; a brother, David Andrews of Easton; three grandchildren, Brian Stevens, Jerry Tolley and Madison Philiposian. He was preceded in death by a sister, Paige

Nielsen of Mechanicsburg, PA.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 17, 2005 at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Dorchester Memorial Park, Cambridge, Md.
