



Robert Wilson McClyment

December 27, 1918 - February 16, 2010

Robert Wilson McClyment died Tuesday, February 16, 2010 at Heartland House in Grasonville, MD. He was 91.

Born December 27, 1918 near Queenstown, MD on Bloomingdale Road, he was the son of the late, William Andrew and Esther Carrie McClyment. He attended school in Centreville, MD and went to work on their family farm, "Dividing Waters". In 1941, during World War II, he joined the U.S. Army serving in the European African Middle Eastern Theater with the 107th Anti-Aircraft Battalion. Following his discharge in 1945 he returned home and began working for the State Highway Administration, retiring January 1981 after 36 years of service. Following his retirement he worked for Tom Helfenbein Funeral Home in Chester, MD and Orrell's Maryland Beaten Biscuits in Wye Mills, MD. On August 6, 1941 he married the former Dorothy Mason of Grasonville, MD. Mrs. McClyment died on September 29, 2006 after 65 years of marriage.

He was an active member of Immanuel United Methodist Church, Grasonville, MD serving 28 years as Sunday School Superintendent, 8 years as Assistant Sunday School Superintendent and 50 years as Communion Stewart. He was a lifetime member of Grasonville VFW Post #7464 serving as Post Commander and Chaplain.

Mr. McClyment is survived by two daughters, Lois Pritt and her husband, Jack of Grasonville, MD and Wanda Harmon and her husband, Jim of Denton, MD; a sister, Elizabeth Barton of Easton, MD; a sister-in-law, Carolyn McClyment of Claiborne, MD; three grandchildren, Brent Pritt, Megan Harmon Samaniego and her husband, Richard and Greg Harmon, as well as many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by three brothers, William McClyment, Henry McClyment, George McClyment and a sister, Frances Harrison.
