



Robin Bell Stallings

August 4, 1941 - May 26, 2009

Robin Bell Stallings died Tuesday, May 26, 2009, at University of Maryland Hospital in Baltimore, MD. She was 67 years old.

She was born on August 4, 1941, in Annapolis, MD, to Robert Stallings and Marie Bell Stallings. Robin was an accomplished ballet dancer and teacher in her early years. She held the record at Annapolis High School for most points scored in a Women's Basketball games for years.

In the late 1960's, Robin got her real estate license and eventually opened her own company, Robin Stallings and Associates in Cape St. Clare and Annapolis. In the late 1980s after a successful career in real estate, Robin and Karen purchased a 90 acre farm in Denton, MD, and Robin became one of the premier breeders of the American Miniature Horse. After her retirement from that successful career, her favorite cause became the Caroline County Humane Society, from which she adopted many dogs. In memory of her son, Robin started the Rod Stalling Memorial Benefit for the Caroline County Humane Society.

Robin is survived by her life partner of 33 years, Karen L. Kilheffer of Denton, MD; son, Ashly W Asbury, daughter, Bridgett M. Barton, and cousin, Sharon Evans of Annapolis. She was preceded in death by her son, Rod Stallings, on September 14, 1996.

A memorial service will be held 11 am on Saturday, May 30, 2009, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Cremation and Funeral Care, P.A., 814 Bestgate Road, Annapolis, MD, where family and friends may call one hour prior.

Interment will follow the memorial service at Hillcrest Cemetery in Annapolis, MD.
