



## Robin Denise Wallace

December 21, 1959 - March 6, 2011

Robin Denise Murphy Wallace of Barclay, MD, died at home on Sunday, March 6, 2011, surrounded by her family and closest friends. She was 51.

Robin was the daughter of Francis and Shirley Murphy and was born on December 21, 1959, in Baltimore, MD. She was a graduate of Andover High School in Linthicum, MD. She moved to the Eastern Shore 23 years ago to raise her family in a country setting.

Her family became active in the Pony Express 4-H club where she was a co-leader. Robin started riding horses at the age of twelve, and further blessed her daughters with those skills to achieve as equestrians. Robin had a great heart and opened it to all her students, family, and friends every moment she had the chance.
