Rodney Thomas Coldwell of Centreville, MD died suddenly from respiratory arrest following an allergic reaction. He was 36.

Born in Warwick, Rhode Island on October 20, 1967, he was the son of Frank and Valerie Coldwell. He grew up in Concord, NH. In the early 1980's he moved to Centreville, MD and was a 1986 graduate of Queen Anne County High School. After high school Rodney began his career as a carpenter with his father's company, Coldwell Builders and later along with his brother, they would become partners of the company. Following his father's retirement he and his brother continued building on the Eastern Shore and recently in western Maryland by Deep Creek Lake.

Rodney enjoyed all the water recreation that the Chesapeake Bay offers; he also enjoyed winter snow sports including skiing and snowmobiling. He was a true sports enthusiast and participated in various recreational sport leagues over the years.

In addition to his parents, Rodney is survived by his fiancé, Pam Bernard of Centreville and a brother, Douglas and his fiancé, Stacy Jeffers of Centreville.
