



Roger Neilson Mangels Sr.

February 17, 1931 - February 12, 2018

On February 12, 2018 Roger N. Mangels, Sr. passed away in Chestertown, MD, from congestive heart failure. He was 86.

Mr. Mangels was born in Baltimore, MD, to Walter B. Mangels, Sr., President of Mangels Herold Company, and Louise Neilson Mangels, a homemaker. Mr. Mangels attended McDonogh School from grades one through twelve, graduating in 1950. He earned the rank of cadet major in his senior year and captained both the wrestling and lacrosse teams. In his senior year, Mr. Mangels joined the Maryland National Guard (29th Division) and served for four years, attaining the rank of Sargent.

Following graduation, Mr. Mangels went to work in the family business, Mangels Herold Company, makers of King Syrup. He served in various positions and ultimately, as President of the company and retired following its sale in 1985.

He and his wife of 60 years, Sally, along with their four children, lived in the greater Baltimore area and maintained a vacation home in Kent County. Their farm on the Chesapeake Bay south of Tolchester became their permanent home in 1972.

Mr. Mangels and his wife were avid supporters of the Washington College

Shoremen lacrosse team and began the annual tradition of the Shoremen Stick Supporters Fish Fry.

His former board affiliations include Light Street Savings & Loan and the Kent & Queen Anne Hospital. He was also founding board member of the Chesapeake Bank and Trust in Chestertown, MD.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 60 years, Sally; daughter, Robin Schepf (Michael); sons, Roger Neilson Mangels, Jr., Walter B. Mangels III (Linda), Carl B. Mangels; seven grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

A visitation will be held on Friday, February 16, 2018, from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD.

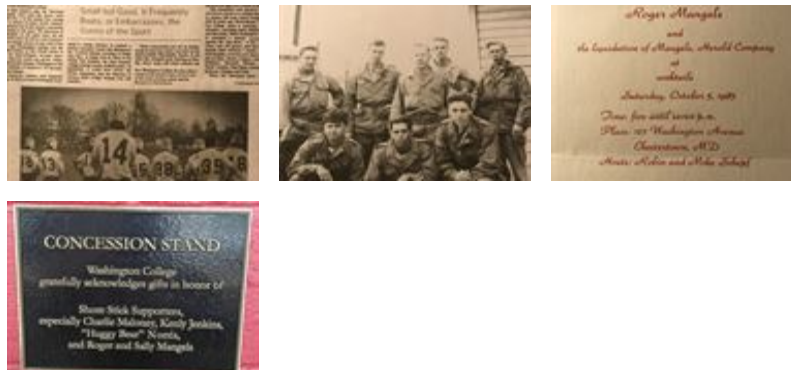

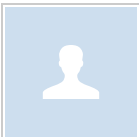

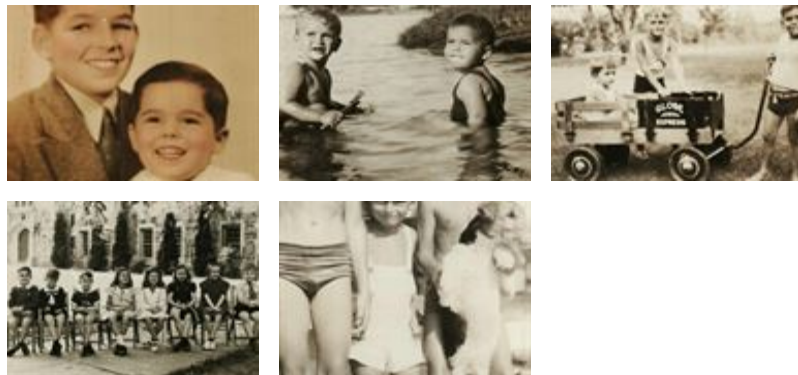
