



Roland D. Clem

December 27, 1934 - February 13, 2014

Roland Diller Clem passed away peacefully on Thursday, February 13, 2014, surrounded by his family.

He was born on December 27, 1934 in Walkersville, MD, the son of the late Ernest and Blanch Virginia Clem. He moved with his family to the Eastern Shore as a young boy. He was educated in the Talbot County Public Schools, graduating from Easton High School in 1953.

In 1958, Ronald married the love of his life, Sally Ann Brannock of Cambridge, MD. He is survived by his wife as well as their children; Elizabeth Vetere of Naples, FL, and David Clem of Easton, MD; a granddaughter, Amanda Clem; his sister, Martha Stoner and her husband, Chuck; and his niece, Sue Marshall. He is preceded in death by two brothers, Ernest (Buck) Clem and Millard (Bill) Clem.

Roland spent his younger years in scouting, earning the highest level of achievement, Eagle Scout. He then served in the National Guard 29th Infantry Division for eight years. His professional career was with the U.S. Postal Service. He served as Easton's Postmaster from 1973 to 1989. Upon retiring, he started R & S Creations with his wife, a craft business they operated for 18 years. Roland was also influential in the Easton Celebrations Organization, serving as Treasurer. He would often be seen entertaining the 4th of July crowds, convincingly dressed as Uncle Sam, with his trademark white hair.

A memorial service will be held on Tuesday, February 18, 2014, at 7 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., in Easton, where friends may call one hour prior.

Interment will be private.
