



Roland Tilghman "Bucky" Larrimore

December 7, 1932 - February 5, 2015

Roland Tilghman "Bucky" Larrimore, of Chestertown, MD, passed away peacefully February 5, 2015, in Chestertown surrounded by his family. He was 82.

He was born in Rock Hall, MD, on December 7, 1932, the son of the late Homer Larrimore and Enid Hubbard Larrimore. He attended Rock Hall High School and graduated with the Class of 1949. Upon graduation, Bucky started classes at Washington College and then enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and served two tours of duty in Korea. After his service to our country, he finished his education at Washington College in Chestertown, graduated in 1962, and was inducted in the College's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1996. In 1963, Bucky started his thirty-five year career as the local State Farm agent for the Chestertown area. Also during this time, he served a term as a Judge of Kent County's Orphans Court, and two terms as a Kent County Commissioner. Bucky enjoyed his family, sports, reading, politics, travel, conversation, gardening, and US history.

Bucky was preceded in death by his sister, Jean Ewing, and brothers, Howard Larrimore and Jack Larrimore. He is survived by the mother of his children, Mary Ellen Lord Larrimore of Chestertown; one daughter, Enid Lum and husband Tommy of Fredericktown; four sons, Mark of Salisbury, John and wife Eugenia of Rock Hall, Matthew and wife Tammy of Chestertown, Garrett and

wife Lisa of Pinckney, MI; six grandchildren, Ryan, Jaclyn, Lexi, Katie, Gavin, and Anna; one brother Carroll "Budsy" and wife Patricia of Middletown, DE. He is also survived by long time companion Barbara Jackson and her family, daughter Lisa Jackson-Cherry and husband Jim and their daughters Gabbi and Alli, all of Grasonville, MD.

Funeral services will be held on February 11, 2015, at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Rock Hall. Family visitation will be at noon, visitation for the public will be at 1 p.m., followed by the service at 2 p.m.

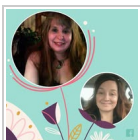
