Roland Ellsworth Marshall, Sr., of Trappe, went home to be with Jesus at Talbot Hospice House on Monday, January 29, 2007. He was 78.

Born in Wittman on September 11, 1928, he was the son of the late Percy and Edith Pollard Marshall. After attending public school in Wittman, he worked on the water and also in the family business, Wittman Packing Company. A successful boat builder, he took over Marshall's Boat Yard of Wittman when his father retired in the early sixties. For over a decade he built custom designed work and pleasure boats for customers all along the eastern seaboard until his retirement in the late seventies due to health reasons. In 1966 he married Shirley Bell of Cambridge and they made their home in Wittman and Cordova until moving to Trappe in February of 2006.

Mr. Marshall's many interests included camping, hunting, fishing, scuba diving and water skiing. He was leader of his son's Boy Scout troop, a former member of the Easton Church of the Nazarene, where he sang in the choir and served as Head Usher. For the past several years he has been a member of the First Wesleyan Church of Easton.

Mr. Marshall is survived by three daughters, Barbara Marshall Teat of Cordova, Bonnie Lahman of Preston and Penny Berman of Easton; a son, Kenny Marshall of Bozeman; two step daughters, Maxine McClyment and
