



## Roland O. Bruscup

Roland Oliver Bruscup of Chester, MD died Wednesday, January 21, 2004 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home. He was 87.

Born on March 9, 1916 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Roland William Hartman Bruscup and Leila V. Johnson. He attended Poly Tech Institute in Baltimore and began working at Bethlehem Steel to assist with the war effort, building ships. He volunteered service with the US Coast Guard Auxiliary, patrolling the waterfront of Baltimore City. During this time, he studied to be a motion picture operator. He served his apprenticeship at Local #181 and became an operator in various theatres in Baltimore City where he retired in 1982, from the "Playhouse" theatre. In 1983, he moved to the Eastern Shore, Kent Island.

He was President of the Local #181 for 12 years, charter member of the Glen Burnie Moose #1456 for 49 years and he transferred to lodge #1831, he was one of the Gents of Kent Island (calendar), a member of the Kent Island Heritage Society where he hosted at the train station and a member of the Galilee Lutheran Church in Chester.

In addition to his wife Myrtle of 61 years, who he married April 5, 1942, he is survived by two sons, Ronald R. and his wife, Lori A. Bruscup of Grasonville and Randy J. Bruscup of Pasadena; one sister, Audrey Virginia Bruscup

Hawkins of Stevensville; one grandson, Nicholas R. Bruscup; two nieces, Virginia Ingling and Carol L. Rimkevicius and two nephews, Allen Ingling, Jr. and Richard Schneider.

Funeral services will be held Monday, January 26, 2004 at 11am in the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Chester, MD where friends and family may call Sunday, January 25, 2004 from 2pm to 5pm.
