Roma W. Miller, 96, of Lanham, MD and Kent Island, MD, passed away in her sleep on December 17, at home. She was born in Boyer Siding, West Virginia and moved as a young child to Sewickley, PA and later moved to New York City, where she graduated from Hunter College with a B.A. in Mathematics. During her career she worked as a geodesist-mathematician in the Coast and Geodetic Survey, Commerce Department computing latitudes, longitudes, and azimuths for Air Force missile bases.

She believed in community service, when her husband was President of the Lanham and Bowie Democratic Clubs, she would do all the cooking for the meetings. After retirement she worked in the school system in Queen Anne's County, MD tutoring children. At the age of 80 she started a bridge club for seniors in P.G. County. Up until the age of 95, she completed the New York Times Sunday crossword every Sunday. She had a big heart. She was loved by everyone who met her and devoted to her family. She never wanted to be anyone other than who she was. She will be dearly missed by those who loved her.

Surviving are her daughters, Joan Delmar Saslaw and Barbara Miller Rodriguez She is also survived by a dedicated son-in-law Roberto Rodriguez, loving grandchildren Robert G. Woodyard, Jr., Allen Saslaw, and Dianna Rodriguez. Predeceased by her husband Frederic H. Miller, and her parents
