



Dr. Ronald Sheryle Brunsvold

October 5, 1945 - October 3, 2023

Dr. Ronald Sheryle Brunsvold passed away on October 3rd, 2023, following a battle with Upper Tract Urothelial Carcinoma.

He was born on October 5th, 1945, in Macon Hospital, Macon, GA, to Lloyd George Brunsvold and Jewell Mae Bryan Brunsvold. Growing up in Warner Robins, Ronald achieved the rank of Eagle Scout. He later graduated Summa Cum Laude from Georgia Tech in Aerospace Engineering in 1968 while co-opting at the NASA facility on Wallops Island, VA. Pursuing further education, he attended the University of Florida, earning a master's degree in 1970 and a Ph.D. in 1974.

Professionally, Dr. Brunsvold contributed to the Naval Surface Warfare Center at White Oak, MD, as a civilian employee of the US Navy. He continued his work in research and development with the US Navy at Crystal City, VA, and later at Strategic Systems in Washington DC, until his retirement in 2003. In 1968, he met Melba Joyce Green, and the two married in 1969. Mrs. Brunsvold taught in the Montgomery County, MD Public School System for 29 years. Outside of his career, Dr. Brunsvold had an interest in woodworking and photography. He set up a woodworking shop in his basement and enjoyed capturing nature and wildlife through his camera. He is survived by his wife, daughter Kori Allison Lambert, three grandchildren (Neve, Thea, and Finn Lambert), and sister Pamala Jan Rummel. He was preceded in death by his parents. A private memorial service will be arranged to commemorate Dr. Brunsvold's life.
