Ronald Scott Hobar died at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD, on Tuesday afternoon, August 27, 2002. He was 51.

Born August 3, 1951, in Cheverly, MD, Ron was the son of John and Rose Krieder Hobar of Lusby, MD. He graduated from Bladensburg Senior High School in 1969 and joined the Metropolitan Police Department of District of Columbia in 1971. He served and retired from the Metropolitan Police Department in Washington, DC, as a Detective II in 1989. On May 5, 1985, he married Freda Yvonne Zamer of Camp Springs, MD, and they resided in Upper Marlboro, MD, and later moved to Queenstown, MD. Ron and Freda frequently spent weekends in Ocean City, MD.

Mr. Hobar was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police in Washington, DC, the Association of Retired Police, and the Fraternal Order of Police. He recently became a member of the Ocean City Marlin Club and he enjoyed deep sea fishing and spending time with his beloved wife, Freda, and their companion, Max.
