Ronald "Ron" William Lee Patrick, Sr. passed away at the Easton Memorial Hospital in Easton, Maryland on October 7, 2025 after a long battle with cancer.

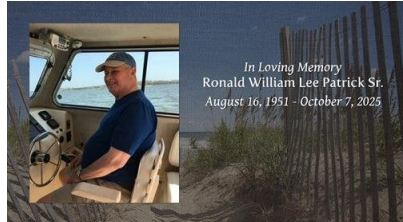
