Ronnie Thomas died Monday, September 7, 2009 at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 65.

Ronnie was born on August 27, 1944 to the late Albert Griffin and Elsie Cecilia Thomas in Chester, MD better known as "Rabbit" on Kent Island where he grew up and attended school. He began his career at an early age, working on the water crabbing, oystering, and clamming before becoming disabled.
