Ronald James Williams of Perry, GA, formerly of Centreville, MD, died at his home on Tuesday, October 9, 2007. He was 73.

Mr. Williams was born July 21, 1934 in Reynoldsville, W.V.; he was the son of the late, Forrest and Eleanor Moore Williams. Following graduation from High School, he began a 26 year career in the United States Air Force as a teletype operator in a ground communications center in Keflavik, Iceland and traversed through various assignments at the Pentagon, Hawaii, Maryland, Germany, and Virginia. He attained the rank of CMSgt and retired in 1980 as Superintendent of Communications in the National Military Command Center at the Pentagon. After retirement from the USAF, Mr. Williams was employed for 19 years as a Technical Staff Member for a government contractor where his communications operational background continued to expand while exercising various airborne and ground Command and Control Communications systems. He resided with his wife Doris in Centreville, MD, until moving to Perry, GA in 2005.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Williams is survived by a son, Forrest Andrew Williams of Pasadena, MD; two daughters and sons-in-law, Sandra K. and Steven Smith of Winthrop, WA, and Anela Melissa and Timothy Pickens of Centreville, MD; five grandchildren and six great grandchildren. He was pre-deceased by a daughter, Theresa M. Williams and a brother, Phillip E.
