



Rose Elizabeth "Libby" Clough

September 4, 1919 - June 9, 2013

Rose Elizabeth "Libby" Kaufman Clough of Centreville, MD, passed away on June 9, 2013. She was 93 years old.

Born September 4, 1919, in Centreville, MD, she was the daughter of the late Floyd Bernard Kaufman, Sr., and Pearl Elizabeth Jackson. Libby, as she was fondly called, was the oldest of eight children and graduated from Centreville High School in 1939. She earned an RN degree from the Emergency Hospital School of Nursing in Easton in 1942 and attended the Margaret Hague Maternity Hospital in Jersey City, NJ, in 1947 for post-graduate courses in obstetrics.

She began her nursing career in 1942 at Easton Hospital, worked briefly at Wilmington Hospital then in 1950 moved to Cambridge Hospital where she was an instructor at Wor Wic Tech School of Nursing and an administrator before retiring in April 1987.

On August 19, 1955, Libby married her beloved late husband, William Raymond Clough, Jr., in Pocomoke, MD, and they made their home in Centreville.

She is survived by many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and nephews, and great-great nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by three

brothers, Floyd Bernard Kaufman, Samuel Robert Kaufman, and John Albert Kaufman; and four sisters, Francis Virginia McGuire, Mildred Louise Conley, Beatrice Eleanor Whitby, and Joyce Lorraine Kaufman.

A funeral service will be held at 11:00am on Friday, June 14, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 408 South Liberty Street, Centreville, where friends and family may call one hour prior to the service.
