



## Rose Ellen Reihl

October 19, 1925 - October 16, 2011

Rose Ellen Reihl of Rock Hall, MD, passed away on October 16, 2011, at Chester River Manor after a short illness. She was 85 years old.

Rose Ellen was born on October 19, 1925, in Piney Neck, Rock Hall, MD. She graduated in 1942 from Rock Hall High School. After graduation, she attended Beauty School in Baltimore while working for the Social Security Administration. In 1948, she married her sweetheart, Edward H. "Pete" Reihl. They were happily married for 63 years. Rose Ellen owned and operated a beauty salon in her home for many years. She later worked with the Kent County Health Department where she retired in January of 2007 after 23 years of service.

She was a member of Wesley Chapel Church and enjoyed singing in the church choir. She later became a member of Raum Chapel Church. Rose was a dedicated member of the Order of the Eastern Star, Chapter #86 in Chestertown where she served as Worthy Matron in 1969. She was an accomplished artist who enjoyed creating beautiful needlework for her friends and family.

In addition to her husband, Rose Ellen is survived by her three children, Petie, Cecil Ann, and Jim, and their spouses, Dave, Joe and Mary Ann; seven grandchildren, Brandi, Jake, Sam, Abe, Lindsey, Hannah, and Sydney; and

several great-grandchildren, relatives and friends.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, October 21, 2011, at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, Route 20, Rock Hall, MD, where relatives and friends may call on Thursday evening, October 20, from 6:00 to 8:00 PM.
