Roseberry Fisher Jewell passed away on Tuesday, August 14, 2007, at Chester River Manor surrounded by his loving family. He was 88 years old.

While attending Perry's Corner School, Mr. Jewell worked on the farm with his father. After school, he began working for the ferry system until being drafted into the U.S. Army, serving in the Pacific until he was honorably discharged in November of 1945. After returning to the United States, Mr. Jewell resided in New Jersey. On January 5, 1946, he married Rose A. Taylor of New Jersey. They moved to Grasonville in 1969 where he owned and operated an AAMCO station before operating a mechanic shop in Grasonville. Mr. Jewell would later work for Friel Lumber Company as a truck mechanic until retiring in 1984. He began crabbing on the Chesapeake and later worked as a courtesy clerk in the Safeway.

He enjoyed camping and traveling. He was a member of the VFW and Moose Lodge.

Mr. Jewell is survived by his loving wife, Rose A. Jewell of Grasonville, MD; three daughters, Barbara Clarke of Federalsburg, MD, Arlene Jewell of Grasonville, MD, and Joy Stant of Grasonville, MD; four sons, Barry Jewell of Rehobeth, DE, Dennis Jewell of Ridgely, MD, Donald Jewell of Houston, DE, Robert Jewell of Macomb, MI; eight grandchildren; and two great

grandchildren.
