Rosemarie H. Smith died on Wednesday, July 23, 2014, at the University of MD Shore Medical Center at Easton. She was 81.

Born in Baltimore on November 29, 1932, she was the daughter of the late Elmer C. and Elizabeth Howard Heilman. After graduating from St. Katherine's Commercial School in Baltimore in 1934, she worked as a secretary at Johns Hopkins Hospital and then for the U.S. Army Chemical Center in Edgewater. She married her husband, Frederick Martin Smith, in Baltimore in 1953. They moved to Easton in 1964 where she first sold Avon products and then worked as a teacher's aide at the Cordova Elementary School for nine years. In 1978, she began working at the Memorial Hospital in Easton as a Medical Records Clerk, where she retired from in 1996.

Rosemarie was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton and also a member of the Ladies of the Elks, Easton Lodge # 1622.

Mrs. Smith is survived by a daughter, Roseanne Elizabeth Towers and her husband, Keith, of Easton; a son, Frederick M. Smith, Jr., and his wife, Heidi, of Camden, DE; four brothers and sisters, Mary Elizabeth Pinkas and Doris Theresa Rampello of Myrtle Beach, SC, and Charles Joseph Heilman and Margaret Mary Ray of Baltimore; one brother-in-law, Clyde Martin Smith of Easton; and five grandchildren, Megan Smith, Kyle Smith, Martina Towers,
