Ross J. Carter, Sr. of Chestertown, MD went home to be with his Lord and Savior on October 31, 2007 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 85.

Born in Baltimore, MD on May 7, 1922, he was the son of the late, Charles and Bessie Smith Carter. He married Ida Mary Collacchi, she predeceased him in August of 2000.

Mr. Carter served in the U.S. Army for 7 ½ years serving in the Northern France, Central Europe, and the Rineland Campaign in the 29th Infantry Division during WWII. He was honorably discharged November 7, 1945. He returned to Baltimore, Maryland and worked as a Meat Cutter with Food Fair in for fifty years. He retired and moved to Ocean City, Maryland where he continued to work during the summer months doing various jobs.

He was a member of the Highlandtown V.F.W., active with Our Lady of Pompeii Catholic Church, and Crumpton Senior Citizens. He enjoyed watching television and movies and was a devoted Ravens Fan. He was dedicated to his family and his work.
