Rosser Lee Parker of Stevensville, MD died Tuesday, October 19, 2004 at Corsica Hills Nursing Facility in Centreville, MD. He was 75.

Born on March 27, 1929 in Irvington, VA, he was the son of the late Ida Johnson & Walter Parker. He was a 1946 Graduate of Woodbridge High School, New Jersey. Following his graduating he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served four years during the end of WWII. In 1949, he was honorably discharged. During the Korean War, he re-enlisted into the Air Force serving 28 years. He began working for the U.S. Postal Service in Largo, MD, as a training officer and retired as a quality control director. On December 16, 1951, he married Dolores Lughes and they resided in New Jersey. Due to his military career, they relocated many times around the world. In 1973 he retired from the Air Force residing in Annapolis, MD. In 1992, they moved to Stevensville, MD.

He was a member of the American Legion and Elks Lodge. He enjoyed reading, crossword puzzles, baseball (O's fan) and football (Redskin's fan).

In addition to his wife Dolores, he is survived by four children, Michael Parker of Prince George's, MD, Patrick Parker of Annapolis, MD, Ross Parker of Winter Park, FL and Alisa Parker of Alexandria, VA and one grandson, Jeremy Parker.
