Rowena Brooks, of Cordova, died at the Genesis Eldercare – The Pines, Easton, on Monday, September 16, 2002. She was 94.

Born on Tilghman, August 15, 1908, she was the daughter of the late Hobson and Nora Sinclair Jones. She was a graduate of the Tilghman High School. In December of 1941, she married James B. Brooks, Jr. a Talbot County farmer. They farmed the Poplar Ridge farm near Cordova for 37 years before his death on April 6, 1984.

A lifelong resident of Talbot County, she was a member of the Wye Mills United Methodist Church in Wye Mills. Former memberships included the Tuckahoe Steam and Gas Association, the Talbot County Farm Bureau and the Women of The Moose, Easton Chapter #1250.

Mrs. Brooks was preceded in death by her first husband, Wilson Tull; a son, Wilson Hobson “Hobby” Tull, Sr.; a grandson, Donald Lee Tull and a brother, Curtis Jones.

Surviving are a daughter, Barbara B. Osolin and her husband, Fritz of Cordova; seven grandchildren, Wilson Hobson Tull, Jr., Peggy Rowena Clough, James Parker Tull, Nora Jean Duty, William Joseph Tull, Lisa Marie Chaires and Kirsten Leigh Gordy; eleven great-grandchildren; one great-great

grandson and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral Services will be held on Friday, September 20th, at 11 A. M. at the Wye Mills United Methodist Church, Wye Mills.
