June 8, 1929 - May 19, 2011

Roxanna Hopkins Crow died on May 19, 2011. She was 81.

Born in Smithson, MD on June 8, 1929, she was the daughter of the late Phillip Edmond and Sadie Emma Williamson Hopkins. She attended school in Preston, and then married Irvin Melvin Crow of Landing Neck. She started raising her family near Easton and then, in 1962, moved to Tilghman Island.

Mrs. Crow was a former member of the Tilghman Wesleyan Church.
