Roxanna Lane Powell of Centreville, MD died Friday, July 16, 2004 at her home. She was 88.

Born on January 5, 1916 in Stevensville, MD she was the daughter of the late Howard S. and Mae Palmer Lane. She was the wife of the late Royden Nathan Powell, Jr. who predeceased her in 2000.

Mrs. Powell was a graduate of Centreville High School Class of 1933 and Beacom College Class of 1935. She worked for Diamond Oil Company for six years and returned to Centreville, MD to marry Royden N. Powell, Jr. on January 18, 1941.
