Roxie McEvoy, 69, of Grasonville, Maryland, died peacefully at her home on July 23rd, 2024. She was born on August 9th, 1954 in Oregon, daughter to the late Richard and Delores Will.

In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by her sister, Ronda Miltimore. She is survived by her loving husband, James; her siblings, Terry Will (Limei) and Rene Pries; nieces Katie Van Epps and Amanda Miltimore; brother in law, John McEvoy; sister in law, Kathleen McEvoy; and her friend of 60 years, Deb Garner, and long-time friend from the park service, Robbin Owen. Roxie also leaves behind her beloved pets, her Italian Greyhound, Cooper and cat, Red.

Roxie attended South Salem High School and graduated in 1972. She worked as supervising Ranger at Greenbelt Park in Greenbelt Maryland, where she hired her future spouse as a seasonal ranger in the summer of 1989. Roxie and James McEvoy married on September 8, 2001, in Potomac Falls, Virginia. In addition to working as a Park Ranger (1987 - 1994), Roxie was also a proud owner of two small businesses: a successful flower shop in Oregon and most recently, JM Sola Salons in MD (2013 - 2022).

Roxie supported organizations that protected defenseless animals. She enjoyed traveling, attending concerts and shows, watching movies on the

couch at home, and spending quality time with family and friends- especially on holidays and birthdays.
