Born in Homestead, Pennsylvania, Roy graduated Bedford High School in 1985 where he was a member of the school band. He graduated from Shippensburg University of Pennsylvania in 1989 with a degree in Criminal Justice. Roy retired from the City of Tallahassee Police Department in July 2014 after 23 years of service. 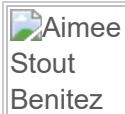
