



## Roy Carl Fox

June 29, 1919 - February 14, 2012

On February 14, 2012, Roy Carl Fox, 92, formerly from Galesville, died in Easton, MD.

Born June 29, 1919, in Birmingham, AL, to Carl A. and Anne V. Fox, he traveled aboard extensively as a youth and completed high school in Pittsburgh. He developed a life-long interest in radios and held an amateur radio license all his life.

Roy graduated from Carnegie Institute of Technology in 1940 with a degree in Electrical Engineering. He worked for Westinghouse for 52 years. During his career, he had the opportunity to work on many cutting edge technologies including radar systems for ships and airplanes, supersonic jets, and satellites as well as radiation monitoring systems for the Nautilus submarine. Roy received six U.S. patents on behalf of Westinghouse.

Roy was an accomplished sailor, living on his sailboat for over 25 years. He was a member of the Sailing Club of the Chesapeake for over 50 years.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m., Saturday, July 14, at Kent Island United Methodist Church, 2739 Cox Neck Road, Chester, MD.
